

SELEX Systems Integration Inc Selected as Second Source for ADS-B Radio Washington DC, 31 Jan 2011

SELEX Systems Integration Inc has been awarded a contract from ITT Corporation as the second source radio supplier for the Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) Automatic Dependent Surveillance-Broadcast (ADS-B) program. Under the contract, SELEX will produce and deliver more than 400 radios during a three year performance period. The radio is intended for use in both ADS-B and MLAT applications. The contract includes options for additional units and for extended depot maintenance support over the service life of the radios. The radios will be manufactured at the SELEX Systems Integration Inc facility in Overland Park, Kansas.

ITT has been under contract to the FAA since 2007 to deploy, operate and maintain the ADS-B ground infrastructure, the cornerstone technology of the FAA's overall Next Generation Air Transportation System (NextGen) initiative to modernize the U.S. National Airspace System. The company recently announced that it had received clearance from the FAA for nationwide rollout of the ADS-B system.

SELEX Systems Integration Inc is the wholly owned US subsidiary of SELEX Sistemi Integrati, SpA – a Finmeccanica, SpA company headquartered in Rome, Italy.
